



FINANCIAL INFORMATION – 2009/10

TUITION: \$17,000 including after school enrichment programs***

FEES

Application Fee	\$100	Non-refundable, due with application for each child
Student Enrollment Fee	\$500	Non-refundable, one-time fee per new student
Deposit	\$1,700	Non-refundable deposit, applied toward tuition, due with signed contract

Supplies-Activity Fee: \$600 This is a yearly fee to cover cost of supplies and copying fees, testing fees (excluding AP testing), fieldtrip within school hours, and PE equipment.

Lab Fee: \$150 This is a yearly fee to cover the cost of lab supplies and equipment that support our science program.

Book Costs: Vary from year to year and must be purchased on line prior to the school year beginning. The cost ranges from \$100 - \$450. We use a book website. Please see admissions package for details.

Yearly Outdoor Overnight Fieldtrip: \$600 Locations vary yearly and differ by grade level.

Tuition and activity, lab, and overnight trips fees – payment schedule after Deposit has been paid**

One-Payment Tuition	Due by April 1st, 2009 is \$16,650.*
Six-payment Tuition	Six equal monthly payments beginning on April 1st, 2009 and thereafter on the first of each month through September 1st, 2009.*
Nine-payment Tuition	Nine equal monthly payments from April 1st, 2009 and thereafter on the first of each month through December 1st, 2009.*
Twelve-payment Tuition	Twelve equal monthly payments from March 1st, 2009 and thereafter on the first of each month through February 1st, 2010.*

Additional Discounts:

There will be a 10% discount for each additional sibling attending New Heights Preparatory School.

Additional Fees:

A service fee of \$800 will be added on all multi-payment plans. See your contract for more details. All contracts must be paid in full by February 2010.

*Please note that if the payment falls on a weekend the payment is due the Monday following the due date.
